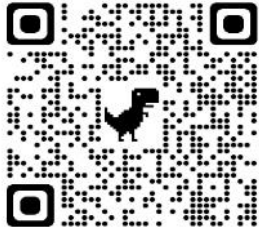

PENTECOST SUNDAY

I encourage everyone to read the article in last Sunday's TABLET concerning the Diocese's Catholic Charismatic Renewal Program Being Revamped. Father John Maduri, pastor of Most Precious Blood-Saints Simon and Jude Parish in Bath Beach, shares some very interesting thought-provoking thoughts on the Holy Spirit in our lives. Father Maduri relates that his relationship with the Holy Spirit "empowers everything I do. I think the enthusiasm I've maintained for my ministry as a priest for 37 years is certainly rooted in that relationship with the Holy Spirit".

On the feast of Pentecost next Sunday, we will be distributing a meaningful prayer pamphlet on the Holy Spirit, one for each family and another one to be given to another person as a way to invite that person to gain spiritual strength from it.

Inside the pamphlet will be an insert with our parish's Mass times, confession, baptism and wedding celebrations, outreach to the sick and homebound and opportunities of catechesis for children and adults.

This past Thursday we celebrated Ascension Thursday in which we celebrated Jesus' going back to His Father in Heaven. However, before going, He commissioned His apostles to continue His mission here on earth. Ultimately, through our own baptism, each of us has been given this commission also. And what was this commission? And what was Jesus' mission that has to be continued: **TO MAKE OUR LOVING AND MERCIFUL GOD KNOWN AND THE WAY THAT OUR DAILY LIVING WILL PREPARE US TO LIVE WITH HIM FOREVER IN HEAVEN!!!**

This task made the apostles very uncomfortable, and they expressed their fear as to how to do this. They felt so unprepared. Jesus promised to send them the Holy Spirit who would help them understand what Jesus had taught and always be with them giving them the strength and all that they would need to be faithful to their call. My dear friends in the Lord, you and I have this task also through our baptism. The promise that Jesus made was fulfilled on Pentecost Sunday when the Holy Spirit came upon the apostles and immediately they became men of strength, courage, etc. and began to preach and teach. Act of the Apostles tells us that 5000 asked to be baptized that very day.

Next Sunday to the right of the altar, you will see a large image of Jesus knocking on the door. If you look closely there is no knob on the door. Jesus continually is knocking on our hearts, so desirous to be welcomed into our hearts and lives. He has so much to give us. However, Jesus never forces Himself into our lives. We have to allow Him in. Above, as has been mentioned, you will be given Holy Spirit prayer pamphlets, one for each family and one to be given to someone else. This will give all of us an opportunity to invite another person to be enriched in their life with God. Jesus is knocking on so many doors!!!!

If possible, may we suggest that everyone try to wear something red on Pentecost Sunday, May 19th.

DOMINGO DE PENTECOSTÉS

Animo a todos a leer el artículo del TABLET del domingo pasado sobre la renovación del Programa de Renovación Carismática Católica de la Diócesis. El Padre John Maduri, párroco de la Parroquia de la Preciosísima Sangre-Santos Simón y Judas en Bath Beach, comparte algunas reflexiones muy interesantes sobre el Espíritu Santo en nuestras vidas. El padre Maduri cuenta que su relación con el Espíritu Santo "da poder a todo lo que hago. Creo que el entusiasmo que he mantenido por mi ministerio como sacerdote durante 37 años está ciertamente enraizado en esa relación con el Espíritu Santo".

En la fiesta de Pentecostés, el próximo domingo, distribuiremos un significativo folleto de oración sobre el Espíritu Santo, uno para cada familia y otro para regalar a otra persona como forma de invitarla a obtener fuerza espiritual de él.

En el interior del folleto habrá un encarte con los horarios de misa de nuestra parroquia, las celebraciones de confesiones, bautizos y bodas, la ayuda a los enfermos y a los confinados en casa y las oportunidades de catequesis para niños y adultos.

Esta tarea incomodó mucho a los apóstoles, que expresaron su temor sobre cómo hacerlo. Se sentían muy poco preparados. Jesús prometió enviarles el Espíritu Santo que les ayudaría a entender lo que Jesús había enseñado y estaría siempre con ellos dándoles la fuerza y todo lo que necesitarían para ser fieles a su llamada. Mis queridos amigos en el Señor, ustedes y yo también tenemos esta tarea a través de nuestro bautismo. La promesa que Jesús hizo se cumplió el domingo de Pentecostés cuando el Espíritu Santo vino sobre los apóstoles e inmediatamente se convirtieron en hombres de fuerza, valor, etc. y comenzaron a predicar y enseñar. El Acta de los Apóstoles nos dice que 5000 pidieron ser bautizados ese mismo día.

El próximo domingo, a la derecha del altar, verás una gran imagen de Jesús tocando la puerta. Si te fijas bien no hay pomo en la puerta. Jesús está continuamente llamando a nuestros corazones, tan deseoso de ser acogido en nuestros corazones y en nuestras vidas. Tiene tanto que darnos. Sin embargo, Jesús nunca entra a la fuerza en nuestras vidas. Tenemos que dejarle entrar. Arriba, como ya se ha mencionado, se os darán folletos de oración por el Espíritu Santo, uno para cada familia y otro para regalar a otra persona. Esto nos dará a todos la oportunidad de invitar a otra persona a enriquecerse en su vida con Dios. **iiiiJesús llama a tantas puertas!!!!**
